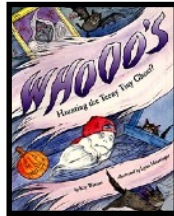
MONDAY Craft Club

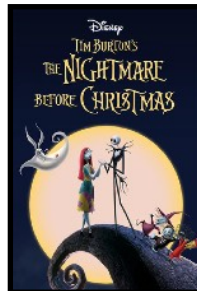
THURSDAY Storytime
