The craft this week was confetti bookmarks. Crafters used clear contact paper, small circles of colored paper, and yarn. Ready to add to a favorite book!



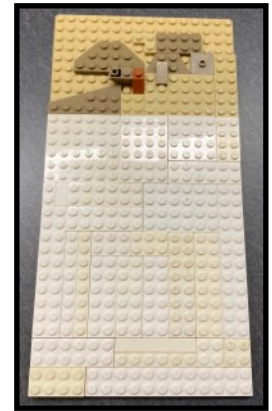
TUESDAY Storytime
